1. A valid Type B Louisiana teaching certificate.*
2. A minimum of 9 semester hours of graduate credit in educational technology including:

3. Persons who have met requirements 1 and 2 may be issued an Educational Technology Facilitation certification endorsement.
4. Certified teachers who have served as a facilitator of educational technology at the building level may petition the Office of Certification and Higher Education to be grandfathered in with an Educational Technology Facilitation certification endorsement if they meet the following qualifications by August 31, 2002:
 - A. Hold certification in computer literacy and have earned an additional six semester hours in educational technology, and have served as a facilitator of educational technology at the school, district, regional, or state level successfully for the past three years as verified by the employing authority

-OR-

- B. Have served as a facilitator of educational technology at the school, district, regional, or state level successfully for the past five years as verified by the employing authority.

* Requires three years of teaching experience

** or ETEC 4840 *Educational Telecommunications, Networks, and the Internet*, if taken for graduate credit prior to Fall 2006.
